With its ancient and dominant spirit, its allure, its uniqueness, this fully restored castle represents a new idea of grandiose luxury, a terrific mixture of classic architecture and contemporary, edgy design. Procopio is possibly the boldest restoration ever attempted in Umbria, commenced in the mid 1980's and finished in 2012, and the results are just outstanding. Originally a military-defence castle and in a totally ruined state it had to go under major structural work, under architect Corrado Giannini, while interiors have been curated by Martyn Lawrence Bullard. The honey-stone castle offers today eight grand bedrooms all with en-suite tailor-made bathrooms, a professional kitchen designed with the help of a chef, a fitness area and a private room for massages and wellness. An exceptional luxury home, this retreat has been carefully crafted to bring luxury and comfort into a rare Italian experience: the interiors feature precious drapes and tapestries, artwork, furniture which, together with the view, create a unique atmosphere: the castle seamlessly blends contemporary standards, including modern plumbing and state-of-the-art appliances together with an evocative atmosphere and precious elements picked from Italian and Umbrian style heritage. Every room has been designed in its very own style, the upholstery has been selected based on the preserved original samples of the period and everything has been manufactured by local craftsmen, using the highest quality materials. The sweeping vistas at Procopio are unrivalled, offering a commanding view of the valley between Umbria

ABOUT PERUGIA

Located in the centre of Italy, the Province of Perugia is Umbria's largest, covering two-thirds of the entire region.

Lifted by a hill above a valley patterned with fields, where the River Tiber runs swift and clear, Perugia is Umbria's petite and immediately likeable capital. Its centro storico (historic centre) rises in a helter-skelter of cobbled alleys, arched stairways and piazzas framed by magnificent palazzi (mansions). History seeps through every shadowy corner of these streets and an aimless wander through them can feel like time travel. Amongst many important folkloristic events taking place in the city Umbria Jazz and Eurochocolate gastronomic festival are definitively worth a visit. Città della Domenica is the first amusement park of Italy for children. Together with its spiritual sister, Assisi, Perugia is a candidate for European Capital of Culture 2019. It is also a bustling university town full of life that has always been the centre of much attention. Perugia is known also for the fine chocolate that is produced there - any visit must be accompanied by some 'Baci' chocolate.

Umbria region is exquisite, mystical, peaceful, and best of all, unspoiled.
